

## LEGAL NOTICE

Sealed bids will be received by Washington Township until 6:00 pm E.S.T. on Thursday July 16, 2026. Bids may be mailed in advance to Thomas Beavers, Fiscal Officer, **21339 Ringgold Southern Rd. Circleville, OH 43113** and must be received prior to July 16, 2026. At 6:01 p.m. E.S.T. on Thursday July 16, 2026, said bids will be publicly opened and read for the construction, furnishing of all materials, labor, and equipment under a unit price contract for the following:

**Washington Township Morris Leist Road Widening Phase II** located in Washington Township, Pickaway County, Ohio in accordance with the bid documents. The project shall consist of road widening, paving and other ancillary items.

**The Engineer's construction cost estimate is \$350,000.**

Proposals must be submitted on the forms supplied and according to the instructions with the Bid Package.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal a Bid Guaranty in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. The bidder may supply for the Bid Guaranty for One Hundred Percent (100%) of the total amount of the bid; or the bidder may supply a Certified Check, a Cashier's Check, or an Irrevocable Letter of Credit for Ten Percent (10%) of the total amount of the bid. Bid security furnished in Bond form, shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.

Washington Township will require all work to be completed on this project by **November 30 2026**.

Each proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder may be required to submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio Products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Pickaway County, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Department of Industrial Relations.
